



- Exclusive Federal Right



Exclusive Federal Right

Section 8 - Powers of Congress

To regulate Commerce with foreign Nations, and among the several States, and with the Indian Tribes;

 Amendment 10 - Powers of the States and People

The powers not delegated to the United States by the Constitution, nor prohibited by it to the States, are reserved to the States respectively, or to the people.




Texas AG Opinion

- 1979 Opinion MW-49, Exhibit 2 (Mark White)
- "The state may not, in the absence of federal authorization, enact laws benefiting these Indians and since there has been <u>no federal authorization</u> in this instance, section 11A is <u>unconstitutional on its face</u>."



Arkansas AG Opinion

- No. 2005-285 (Mike Beebe)
- "In my judgment, the subject matter [Lost Cherokees of Arkansas] of your proposed constitutional amendment is not reserved to the people of the State of Arkansas by the 10th Amendment to the U.S. Constitution."








Kansas 'Tribe' & Illegal Immigrants



Malcolm L. Webber
(a.k.a. Grand Council Chief
Thundercloud IV)

- Illegal immigrants paid \$50-\$1400 for "tribal" membership thus US citizenship
- Documented since 1975 when Webber listed himself as Principal Chief of the Etowah Cherokee Nation of Georgia
- Known publisher of the Cherokee Nation Times and Etowah American Indian News
- Self-declared Chief of Kaweah Indian Nation






Actions Requested...

- Lobby for Federal Laws Making Impersonation of Tribes and Tribal Citizens a Felony (Identity Theft)





- Amend Federal Indian Arts & Crafts Act to Exclude 'State' Recognized Tribes






Principal Chief: Michael "ManFox" Buley & Mother Southern Cherokee Nation
